

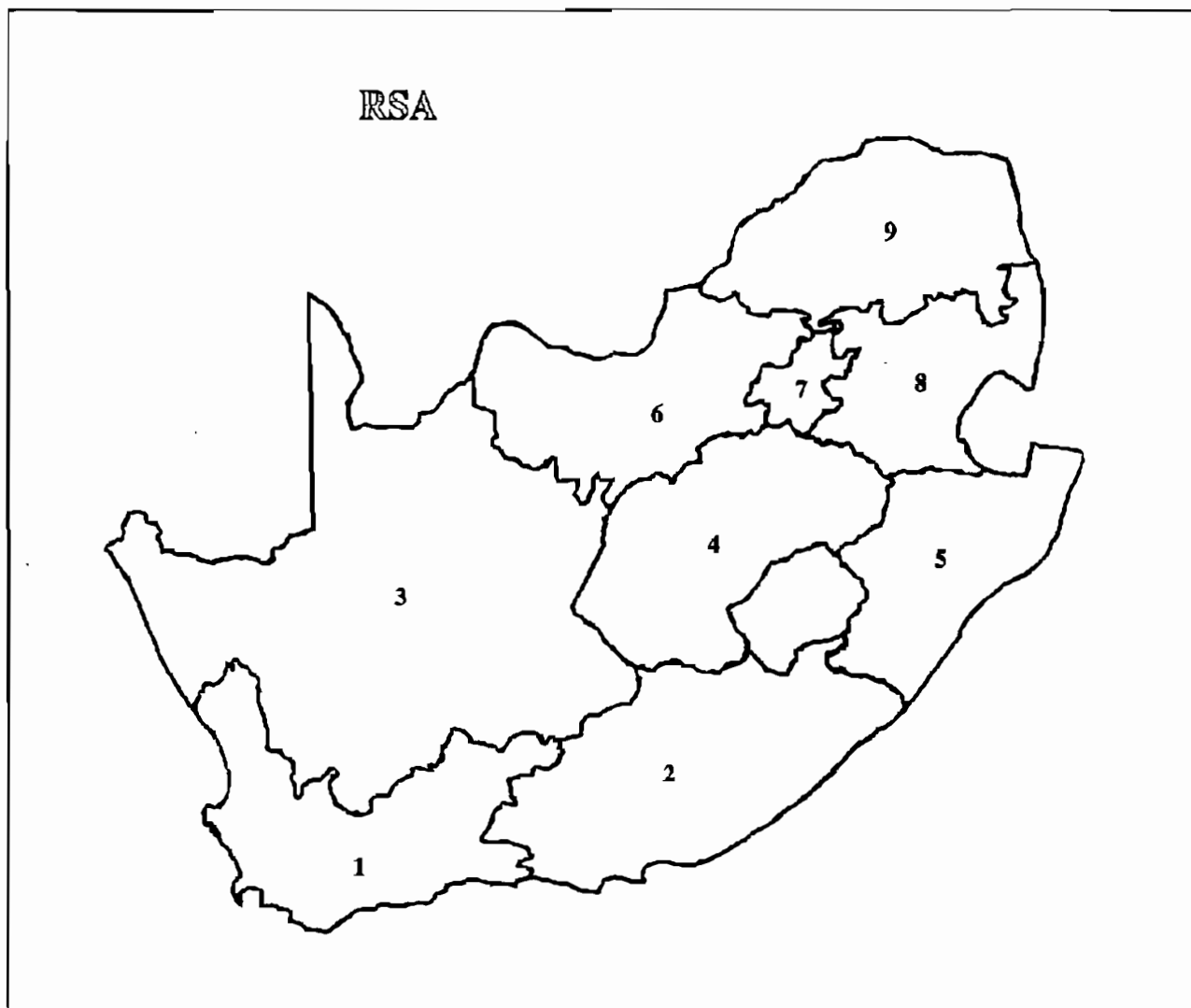

PREFACE

This report contains a summary of the results of the Census of Agriculture for the RSA undertaken in respect of 1993. Commercial farming units in the former TBVC states and self-governing territories are not included. Reports containing the results of the various provinces, will be published in due course.

As a result of the poor co-operation of respondents in respect of the 1993 Agricultural Census, the collection of questionnaires could not be concluded on the date planned. In fact a sufficient number of questionnaires was not received in order to provide reliable results on magisterial district level in all cases. Of the net number of 57 980 respondents involved in the census, 18 609 did not respond and provision had to be made statistically for these cases. The non-response rate of 32,1% had a substantial effect on the final results in certain areas.

This report was printed by means of a computer. INTERPRETATIVE SUMMARY

1. GENERAL

The Central Statistical Service conducted a Census of Agriculture in 1993 covering all commercial farming units in South Africa, excluding those in the former TBVC states and the self-governing territories. The farmers were requested to provide information regarding both production and financial activities for the year ended on any date between 1 March 1992 and 28 February 1993. Of the 57 980 questionnaires which were sent out to the farming units, 39 281 were completed and returned. Data for the non-responding units (32,1%) were estimated.

This report gives a breakdown of principal agricultural statistics such as the number of farming units, employment, salaries and wages, gross income, expenditure and debt according to the nine provinces, excluding farming units in the former TBVC states and self-governing territories. The report is useful for planning in general, and agricultural development planning in particular, at both provincial and national levels.

2. ANALYSIS OF THE RESULTS

2.1 Farming units

In 1993, most of the 57 980 commercial farming units in South Africa (excluding the former TBVC states and self-governing territories) were situated in the Free State (10 252 units), followed by the Western Cape (8 352 units), KwaZulu-Natal (6 080 units) and the Northern Cape (5 053 units) (see Table 1). Only 2 500 units were situated in Gauteng. According to the 1992/93 Census, the average size of a farming unit in South Africa was 1 427 hectares. The largest farming units with an average size of 4 545 hectares were recorded in the drier areas such as the Northern Cape. In Gauteng the average size of a farming unit was only 270 hectares. Most of the farming land was used for grazing purposes (83,5%) and only 1,6% was under irrigation.

2.2 *Employment and Salaries and Wages*

The results of the Census of Agriculture of 1993 show that the number of paid workers employed by the formal agriculture business sector decreased by approximately 6,6%, from 1 219 648 in 1987/88 to 1 093 265 in 1992/93. In 1992/93, 76,9% of the paid employees were blacks. Nearly half of the employees were casual and seasonal workers.

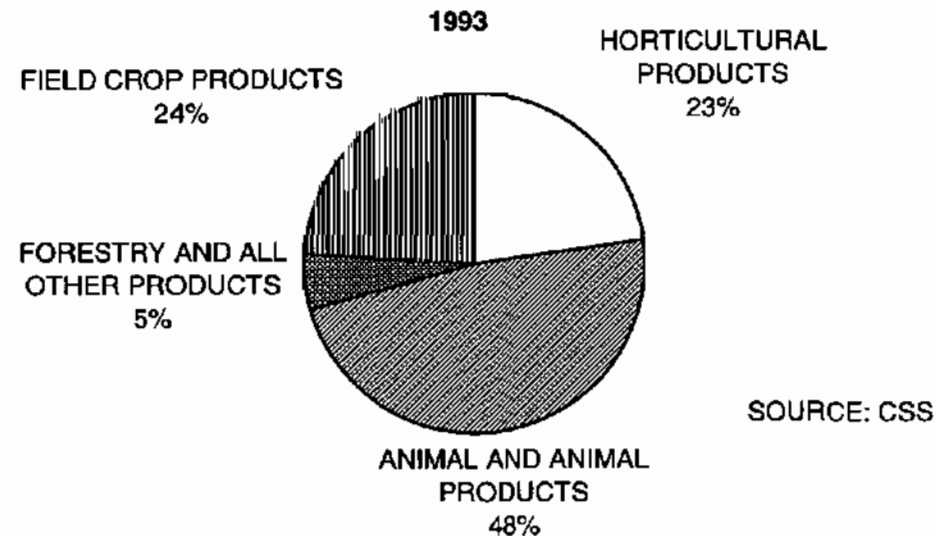
Farmers in the Western Cape employed the largest number of paid employees (202 962 or 17,8% of the total number of paid employees) followed by KwaZulu-Natal (165 505 or 14,5%) and the Free State (161 979 or 14,2%). The Gauteng province employed only 3,0% (34 302 farm workers). (See Table 1). The commercial agricultural sector employed more than 8,0% of the economically active population, thus emphasizing the role played by the sector in providing employment.

The commercial agricultural sector paid R2 787 million in wages and salaries for the year ended 28 February 1993. This amount is 14,2% of the gross income generated by the agricultural sector in 1992/93 and is also 17,0% of the total expenditure by the sector for the same period (or 19,4% of total current expenditure by the sector). In addition, an estimated R851 million was paid in other forms of remuneration such as payments in kind.

2.3 *Gross Income*

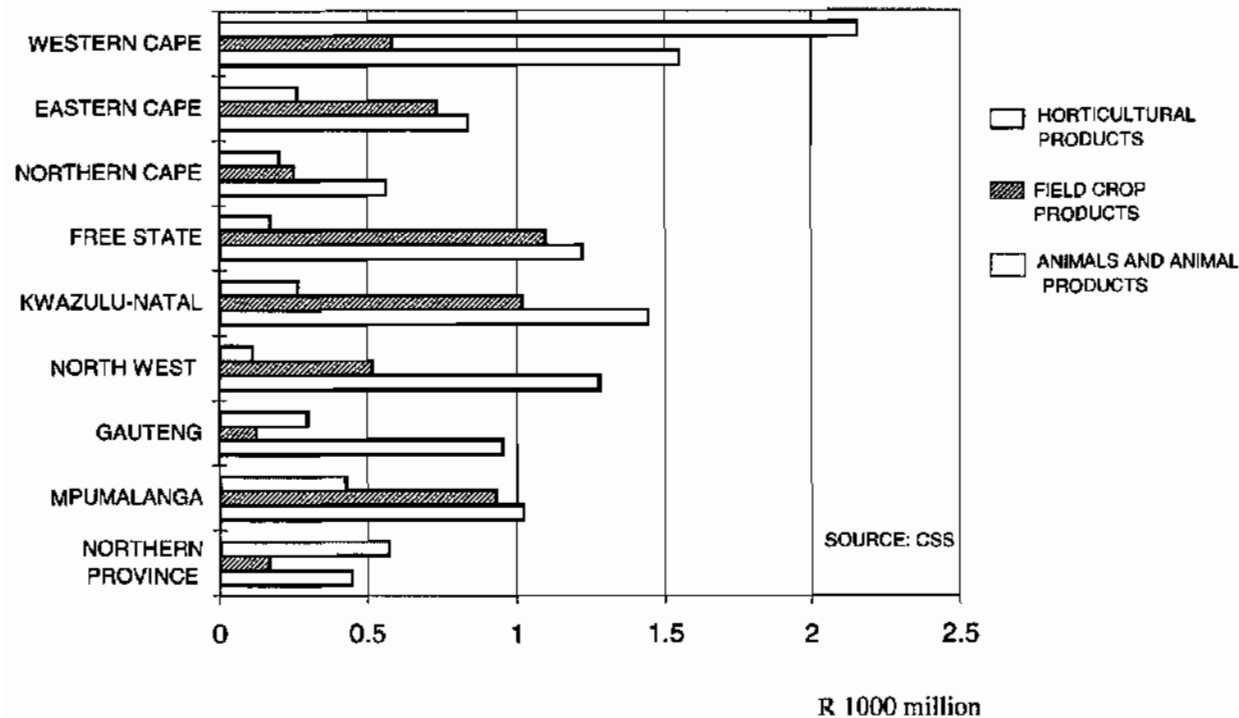
The commercial agricultural sector generated an income of R19 620 million in 1992/93 which was just more than 5% of the Gross Domestic Product for 1992/93.

More than R9 billion (or some 47,7%) of the gross income generated in 1992/93 was from commercial farming in animals and animal products. Field crops and horticultural products were the second and third largest sources of income in the sector with contributions of 24,3% and 22,9%, respectively. Forestry contributed only 4,7%. It is worth noting that the percentage contribution of the different kinds of farming to the total gross income earned from farming hardly changed since 1987/88 indicating that the structure of the agricultural sector has remained fairly stable since the previous agricultural census. Climatic conditions, topography and other geographic factors make it difficult for farmers to shift from one line of farming to another without adversely affecting the viability and profitability of their farming operations. It could also be a reflection of fairly stable prices (perhaps due to the intervention of the various marketing boards).

In all the provinces (excluding the former TBVC states and self-governing territories), except the Western Cape and the Northern Province, commercial farming in animals and animal products is the dominant branch of farming. The largest incomes earned from animals and animal products were recorded by the Western Cape (R1 547 million), the Free State (R1 219 million), KwaZulu-Natal (R1 443 million) and North West (R1 278 million). Regarding field crop products, the Free State and KwaZulu-Natal recorded incomes of R1 096 million and R1 017 million, respectively. In the Western Cape the largest income (R2 153 million) was generated from horticultural products.

2.4 Expenditure and Farming Debt

The total expenditure by the formal agricultural sector in 1992/93 was R16 377 million. Only 12,7% or R2 079 million of this amount was capital expenditure on new assets while 87,3% was current expenditure. The percentage allocated to capital expenditure was 5,0 percentage points lower than the R1 863 million allocated for this purpose in 1987/88.

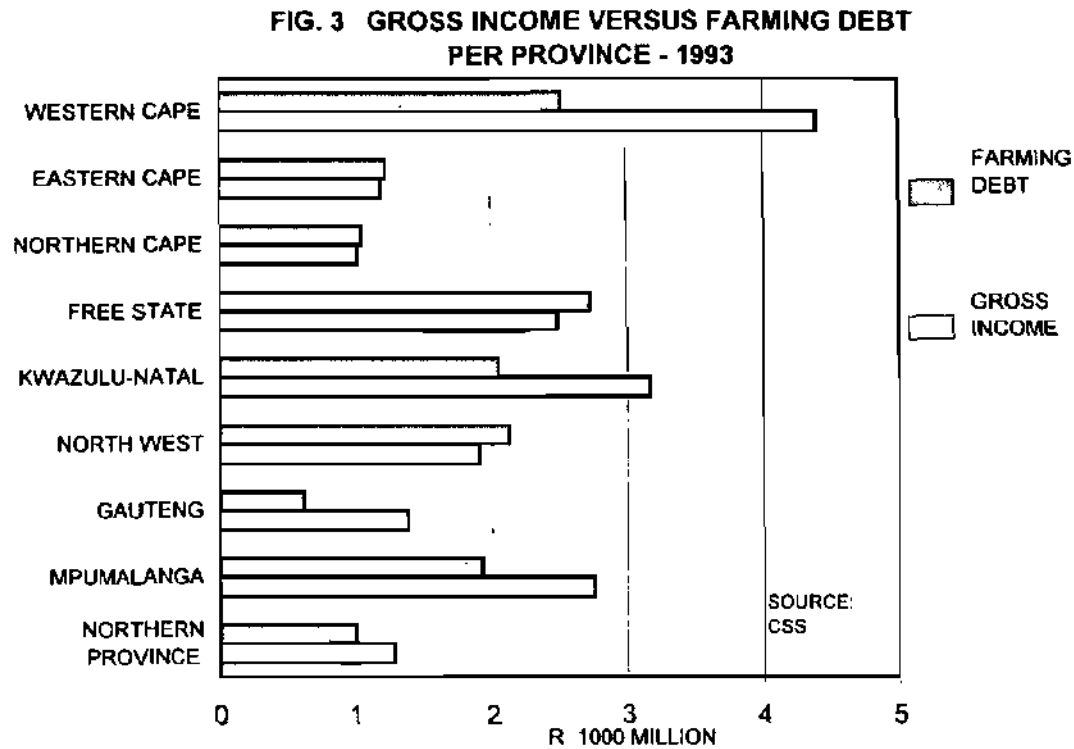
The results of the 1993 Census of Agriculture show that farming debt amounted to more than R15 295 million. The Free State contributed 17,8% to the overall farming debt in South Africa followed by the Western Cape and North West, while Gauteng contributed the smallest amount (4,1%). Of the total interest paid (R1 731 million or 12,9% of the total current expenditure in 1993), the Free State, Western Cape and North West contributed R342 million (19,7%), R300 million (17,3%) and R56 million (3,3%) respectively (see Table 2).

The overall debt ratio (farming debt/farming assets) increased from 17,4% in 1987/88 to 22,9% in 1992/93. This could be indicative of a deterioration in the liquidity position of the commercial agricultural sector.

Furthermore, the results show that commercial banks are the largest (31,6%) source of credit finance to the commercial agricultural sector, followed by the Land Bank (20,0%) and co-operatives (15,6%).



Explanatory notes

1. SCOPE OF THE AGRICULTURAL CENSUS
 - 1.1 For purposes of the agricultural census, farming means -
 - the cultivation of field crops, fruit, grapes, nuts, seed, bulbs, vegetables or flowers;
 - nurseries, excluding those predominantly engaged in reselling;
 - the operation of tea, coffee, sugar, timber or other plantations;
 - the breeding of livestock, game, poultry or other animals, including freshwater fish, furred animals and speculation in livestock; and
 - the production of milk, cream, wool, fur, eggs or honey, for commercial purposes.
 - 1.2 Data in respect of agricultural holdings in urban areas, i.e. areas having some form of local authority, are included in this report. Only those cases where the products were intended for sale are included, such as nurseries, vegetable gardens, flower farms and dairy farms.
 - 1.3 The data refer to farmers in the Republic of South Africa who worked on their own or rented farms or farmed land on shares. Data in respect of farmers and farming units in the former TBVC states and the self-governing territories are excluded.
2. DEFINITIONS AND CONCEPTS USED
 - 2.1 Census year - Details relating to the area of the farming unit, the number of working proprietors/tenants and members of the family, the number of paid employees/farm employees, the number of animals and farming debt were requested as at 28 February 1993. Employees' remuneration, gross farming income and expenditure, field crops and horticultural products produced, animals and animal products sold, equipment purchased and the amount spent on the erection of buildings and development work undertaken, refer to the financial year of the farming unit which ended on any date between 1 March 1992 and 28 February 1993, while the market value of farming assets was requested as at the end of the financial year of the farming unit.
 - 2.2 Farming unit - A farming unit consists of one or more separate farms, holdings or portions of land whether contiguous or not, provided they are situated in the same magisterial district and are operated as a single unit. Farms or portions of land situated in different magisterial districts are regarded as separate farming units. The number of farming units, therefore, does not represent the number of farmers, as a specific farming unit can be operated by more than one farmer, and one farmer can operate more than one farming unit.
 - 2.3 Farmer - The farmer is the person, enterprise or establishment conducting farming operations for his/its own account, irrespective of the ownership of the land farmed; or the manager, foreman or any other person in control of the farming activities.
3. COMPARABILITY WITH PREVIOUS CENSUSES/SURVEYS
 - 3.1 In comparing the results of this census with those of previous censuses/surveys the following should be borne in mind -
 - alterations in the boundaries of geographical areas;
 - fluctuating climatic conditions;
 - alterations in branches of farming and
 - rotation of crops.

3.2 In cases where the slaughtering, processing and packing of poultry are undertaken by the farmer as an integral part of poultry-farming on the same agricultural unit, these activities are classified under agriculture. Similarly, the drying/processing of tea leaves, if undertaken by the farmer in conjunction with the cultivation of tea on the same agricultural unit, is classified under agriculture. Before 1988 these activities were considered as manufacturing and thus excluded from the agricultural censuses/surveys.

3.3 In cases where stock-farmers, in addition to their normal farming activities, also speculate with livestock, income was included. Before 1988 speculation activities were excluded from the agricultural censuses/surveys.

4. NOTES TO TABLES

4.1 General

4.1.1 In order to ensure the confidentiality of individual respondents' data, products/items were combined in certain cases and in other cases indicated with "... (not available).

4.2 Table 1 - Principal statistics

4.2.1 Farming units

The total number and the total area of farming units may reflect fluctuations from year to year. These differences can be ascribed, inter alia, to -

- inconsistencies in the areas reported from year to year by individual farmers;
- annual fluctuations in the total number and the total area of the farming units enumerated as a result of, for example, fluctuations in the composition of farming units and temporarily unoccupied (inactive) farming units, which are not included in the survey; and
- continual withdrawal of land for mining, industrial, commercial and residential purposes.

4.2.2 Tables 1.1 and 1.2

4.2.2.1 "Regular employees" include farm managers/farm foremen and other regular employees who normally do farm work.

4.2.2.2 "New development work undertaken" includes establishment costs.

4.2.3 Tables 1.3 to 1.7.2

4.2.3.1 "Proprietors and tenants" include family members actively involved in the farming operation who do not receive regular salaries.

4.2.3.2 "Paid employees" include regular, casual and seasonal employees.

4.2.3.3 "Employees' remuneration" refers to payments made to paid employees (see 4.2.3.2).

4.2.3.4 "Wages and salaries" refer to cash wages, salaries and cash bonuses.

4.2.3.5 "Other remuneration" includes payments in kind, free housing and free land utilisation.

4.2.3.6 "Gross income" refers to gross income earned from agricultural activities.

4.2.3.7 "Capital expenditure" refers to equipment purchased, buildings erected and development work undertaken.

4.2.4 Tables 1.4 to 1.6

4.2.4.1 Stubs (row descriptions) in respect of farming unit, number of employees and income size groups are omitted in cases where no returns in respect of the said size group were received.

4.2.5 Table 1.7

4.2.5.1 The following farming activities are distinguished:

- Field crops
- Horticulture
- Animals
- Forestry
- Mixed.

4.2.5.2 A farming activity is considered as dominant if the gross income from that activity represents the relatively largest portion of the total gross farming income of the farming unit, otherwise it is considered as mixed. Dominance on the 50% level is shown in Table 1.7.1, while that on the 75% level is shown in Table 1.7.2.

4.3 Table 4 - Employment

4.3.1 Regarding employment, the following are distinguished:

- Proprietors who farm themselves, part-time farmers and tenants.
- Family members actively involved in the farming operation.
- Paid employees.

4.3.2 "Paid employees", the following are distinguished:

- "Regular employees" such as farm managers/farm foremen and other regular employees who normally do farm work (including domestic workers and gardeners).
- "Casual and seasonal employees" such as shearers, reapers and fruit-pickers, excluding contractors and their employees.

4.4 Tables 5 and 6 - Employees' remuneration

4.4.1 "Total remuneration" includes cash wages, salaries and cash bonuses and other remuneration.

4.4.2 The following employees' remuneration are distinguished:

- Cash wages, salaries and cash bonuses.
- Other remuneration. The following "other remuneration" are distinguished:
 - "Payments in kind" refer to the value of rations and other remuneration, such as maize, flour, slaughter animals, meat, fish, milk, wine, bread, coffee, sugar, tobacco, clothing, shoes, transport, training and medicine provided to farm workers, including medical expenses paid on their behalf.

- . Free housing.
- . Free land utilisation.
- . Contributions to the Workmen's Compensation Fund and Unemployment Insurance Fund.
- . Contributions to the pension, medical and other such funds.

4.5 Tables 7 and 8

4.5.1 Combination of products

- In order to ensure the confidential nature of data furnished by individual farmers, information relating to a few farms is either not released or is published in such a manner that the data furnished by any particular farm are not disclosed. For this reason products with relatively small contributions were either included in the category "other" or in the "total".

4.5.2 Combination of areas

- Magisterial districts in respect of which no data were reported were omitted.
- Magisterial districts with relatively small contributions were combined and shown as the "rest of statistical region" to ensure the confidential nature of data of individual farmers.

4.6 Table 7 - Gross income earned from agricultural activities

4.6.1 Gross income earned from the following types of activities is distinguished:

- Field crop products
- Horticultural products
- Animals and animal products
- Forestry products
- All other products.

4.6.2 "Animals and animal products" include gross income from livestock, poultry, game, fish and all other animals.

4.6.3 "All other products" include gross income from wild flowers, compost and firewood.

4.7 Table 8 - Area planted and volume of production

4.7.1 Regarding volume and area, the following are distinguished:

- Field crop products such as summer cereals, winter cereals, fodder crops, oil-seeds, legumes and other field crop products.
- Horticultural products such as vegetables, fruit, nuts, tea and coffee.

4.8 Table 9 - Animals and animal products

4.8.1 Animals and animal products such as livestock, poultry, ostriches and game.

4.9 Table 10 - Animals as at 28 February 1993

4.9.1 Regarding animals, the following are distinguished:

- Cattle
- Sheep
- Goats
- Other livestock (pigs)
- Game

4.10 Table 11.1 - Current expenditure

4.10.1 "Seed and plant material" exclude vine cuttings and plant material purchased for plantations and orchards.

4.10.2 "Other agricultural services" such as ploughing, harvesting, threshing, baling, picking, spraying and shearing refer to services rendered by, for example, contractors and co-operative societies.

4.10.3 "Maintenance and repairs to machinery" refer to all machinery, vehicles, agricultural implements, pumps and other equipment, including, for example, spare parts for motor vehicles, tractors and implements.

4.10.4 "Insurance premiums" relate to premiums on, for example, crops, buildings, vehicles, machinery, implements and animals.

4.10.5 "Other farming expenses" include banking costs and telephone accounts, but exclude cash wages, salaries and cash bonuses, depreciation and purchased assets, such as livestock.

4.11 Table 11.2 - Capital expenditure

4.11.1 "Other buildings" such as milking sheds, pigsties, poultry houses, calf pens, stables, barns, store rooms, garages and all other outbuildings.

4.11.2 "Development work undertaken" such as fencing erected, gates erected, boreholes, dams, troughs, canals, bush clearing, contour banks, irrigation and drainage furrows, pit silos, plunge dips, kraals, plastic tunnels, roads, bridges and power-lines.

4.11.3 "Establishment costs of orchards and plantations" refer to new orchards and plantations including the purchase of plant material, trellising material, re-establishment and conversion and the preparation and fertilisation of soil.

4.11.4 "Goods vehicles" include pick-ups, jeeps and trucks.

4.11.5 "All other equipment and implements" include trailers, ploughs, planters, mowers, crop-spraying equipment, equipment for irrigation systems, milking machines, driers and computers.

4.12 Table 14 - Farming debt

4.12.1 "Farming debt" includes all obligations incurred for normal farming activities and for personal and domestic purposes such as mortgages, loans and credit received from organisations such as banks, co-operative societies and private persons. Debt regarding interests in other business enterprises is not included.

4.12.2 Particulars regarding farming debt are based on the data submitted by the relevant respondents.

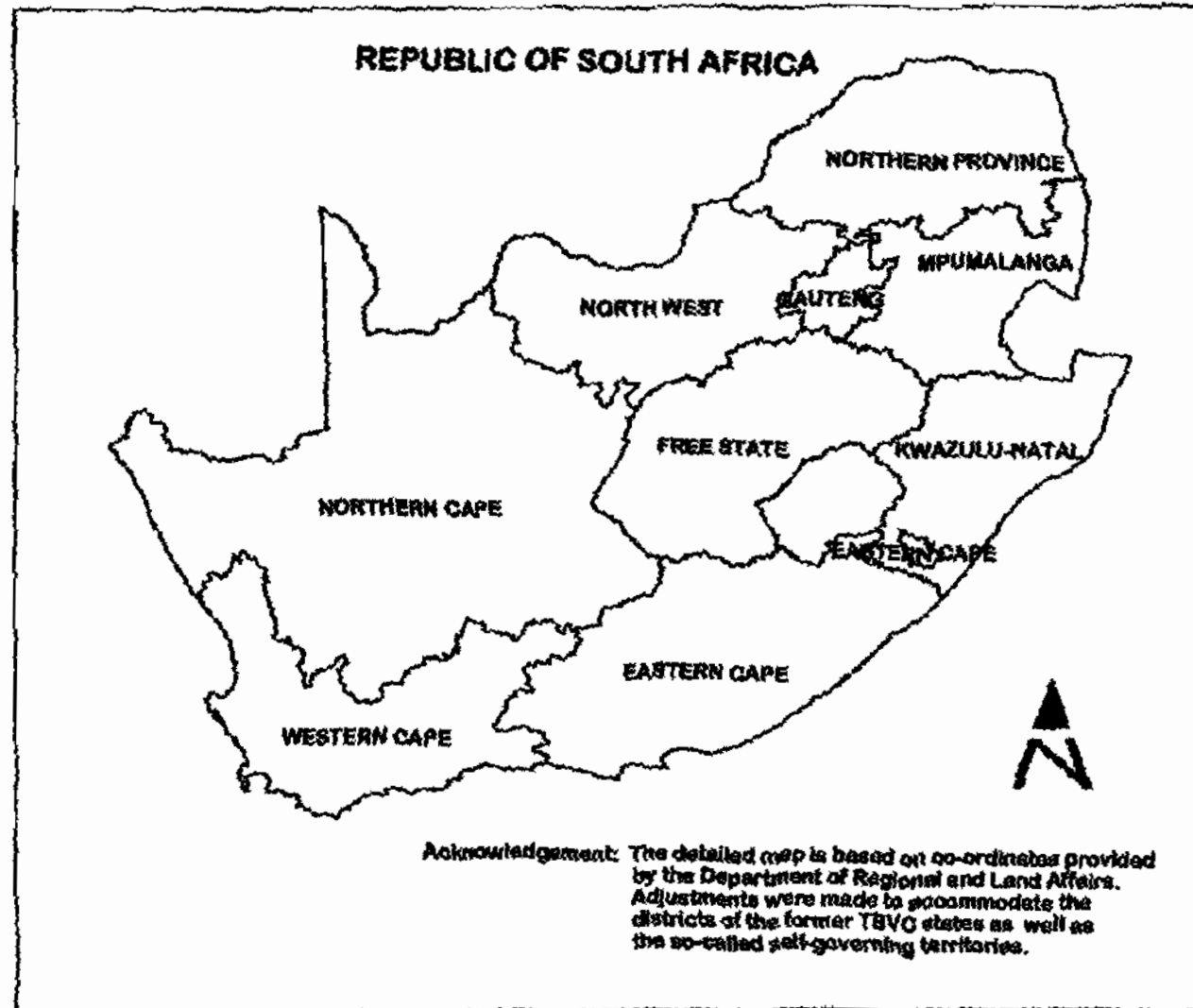
